

Fidenza: 27,000 inhabitants, 24 km west of Parma Town, Emilia Romagna region, northern Italy – just between Milan and Bologna. A relatively rich town, with a strong industrial sector and agrifood excellence. The small city centre retailing network is healthy. 12,000 household, 2,500 businesses, 16,000 employees.

Income Index: 118. Consumption Index: 123.

2001

San Donnino Multiservizi is the Fidenza 100% **public company**, born for the management of several **public services** (environmental services, gas distribution and sale, water distribution, sewerage and purification)

2006

San Donnino Multiservizi is entrusted with the management of the **waste collection**

2007

Door-to-door collection is introduced throughout the municipal area (95 km2).

2018

The Company is **re-entrusted of the waste collection and management service** by the regional authority (ATERSIR), which certifies the quality of the territorial experience, unique in the Parma province, which has been able to maintain **extremely low tariff levels**, within the regional framework, guaranteeing **environmental and management good results**.

2019

From January 1st 2019 the company begins to acquire **direct management of the service** (which comes into operation in 2020): the service is carried out exclusively by **internal staff**.



direct management

Today **35 employees** working for the company, including organizational and operational personnel

benefits

- Flexibility
- Timeliness of intervention
- Control over business costs
- Direct feedback on the service

critical issues

- Staff optimization (transition from supervisors to producers of the service: issues on the job training, administration, safety at work...)
- Direct problem management (direct contacts with users)
- Service chain: waste quality

The signals example

The management of the signals from the city users is an example of the benefits / critical issues of direct management. The company is directly accountable towards citizens, and collects immediate feedback that allows it to intervene quickly and flexibly A management software dedicated to signals from city users is planned for 2023. It will manage all the Town Services Signals



The cost of the service is identified as the expenses incurred for all the activities included in the waste management service, divided by the number of inhabitants residing in the area to which the service refers







Lesson learned: quality of the material




The commitment of San Donnino Multiservizi in recent years is aimed at the quality of the selection of the material and the sending for recovery. After the introduction of good practices, the quality of separate waste is the primary goal.

the **glass** example:

- 2020: dedicated collection (previously carried out with plastic and cans)
 - = higher residue quality
- increased collection rate
- economic benefits

And something about Compost...





citizens are provided by the company with organic **bags** and a small domestic **bin** on the days of **exposure**, the bags are collected in the special bins (for individual users or condominiums)

approximately **2400 tons** of bio waste are produced **every year**

bio waste is sent to a *recovery and recycling industry* in Montello (BG), 137 km from Fidenza. Through **anaerobic processing**, the waste is transformed into **compost for**
